[Deliana Garcia](#), MA has dedicated more than 25 years to the health and wellness needs of migrant and other underserved populations. Throughout her career, she has worked in the areas of reproductive health, sexual and intimate partner violence, access to primary care, and infectious disease control and prevention.

Ms. Garcia is responsible for the development and expansion of Health Network, an international bridge case management and patient navigation system to make available across international borders the health records of migrants who have been diagnosed with infectious and chronic diseases.

She has also served as the principal investigator or research team member for studies that have addressed topics such as sexual and intimate partner violence prevention among Latino migrant and immigrant families; trauma in transit for migrants crossing international borders; as well as emotionally charged dialogue between patients and health care providers.
